## **Project goals:**

Main m objective of the project is to highlight the church cultural heritage in the border area from the perspective of revitalization of the properties and making them accessible to the public to become new points of interest for the visitors.

### **Project and activity summary:**

On the Slovak side, the project will include the restoration of epitaphs and tombstones in the so-called Archbishop's crypt located under the Dome of St. Martin in Bratislava. Digitization of the Cathedral of St. Martin and a new way of promoting this national cultural monument will be created. In addition, the project will create a new tourism product: The Journey of the Early Christian Saints. It will consist of processing databases of

churches in which the relics of saints are located and which are located on the border. The database will become the basis for the creation of a website with a digital map of church monuments. The project will also include a professional conference on the following topics: restoration and reconstruction of religious historical monuments inscribed on the list of monuments. The following activities will be implemented on the Slovak side:

- 1) Restoration of marble epitaphs in the crypt of the Cathedral of St. Martin in Bratislava
- 2) Creation and installation of two digital information kiosks
- 3) Creation of the tourist product The Journey of the Early Christian Saints
- 4) Professional conference

The project is implemented in the partnership of the two church organizations. The Lead partner is the Rímskokatolícka cirkev, Bratislavská arcidiecéza (Roman Catholic Church, Archdiocese of Bratislava) and the main cross-border partner is Mosonmagyaróvári Szűz Mária királynő és Szent Gotthárd Romai Katolikus Plébánia (Roman Catholic parish of St. Mary Queen and St. Gotthard in the city of Mosonmagyaróvar).
